WINEMAKER'S NOTES

2023 VINTAGE REPORT

2023 saw a much later start to vintage due to higher-thanaverage winter rains followed by mild spring and summer temperatures. Above-average yields also added to the slow ripening time.

The lovely, aromatic, balanced whites and elegant, structured, somewhat spicier, peppery reds reflect the mild conditions. The wet start to the growing season added disease pressure with downy mildew reducing the crop, and botrytis reared its head in late-ripening vineyards. Harvest finished in early May, and it was a struggle to ripen some of our Eden Valley reds fully. Overall, 2023 was a cooler and fresher vintage expression, and we missed out on some of our premium parcels of Eden Valley fruit. On the plus side, our dams in the Eden Valley are full for a change!

It's another cracking, cooler vintage.

Colour: Mid straw with brilliant, pale gold hues.

Aroma: An inviting and fresh aroma of citrus, peach, tropical fruit and cucumber combined with a touch of marzipan adding complexity.

Palate: Fresh melon flows through the palate blending into peach and citrus in the mouth. Hints of nutty and creamy barrel-ferment characters and a zesty finish are balanced by a lovely texture, some minerality and zingy acidity.
